Pay commensurate with credentials and experience.

The successful candidate will demonstrate undergraduate-level teaching competency in Youth & Family classes. The appointee will also demonstrate a commitment and capacity for teaching excellence, student mentorship, scholarly and professional engagement, and campus and community citizenship. Crossroads College is committed to excellence in teaching, and the ideal candidate will value clear communication and effective instruction.

Crossroads College is a four-year Evangelical Christian undergraduate institution. Founded in 1913, the college equips students for leadership in many fields, with an emphasis on education for vocational ministry. The college is located in Rochester, MN, a medium size city with a population of around 110,000. The city had long been a fixture on Money magazine's "Best Places to Live" index, and was ranked number 67 on the 2006 list, and in the top 3, including number one multiple times, from 1993-1997.
